My name is Elizabeta Ruzic. I was born in 1996 in Pula. I attended elementary music school in Porec and played the piano. In 2015, I graduated from the language high school in Pazin. After winning the third prize at the state event in 2015 for the video work "Self-portrait", I decided to enroll in the Art Academy in Split, majoring in Film and Video. In Dubrovnik at the 2015 Film Festival, I won the first prize for the experimental film "Self-Portrait" in the open category.

I have participated in several group photo exhibitions.

In 2018, I completed my undergraduate studies, and enrolled in the graduate course Media Art and animation.

In 2019, with the work "Burning", I participated in the group exhibition "Burning Body" organized by HULU Split. That year my short film " Sometimes it's easier to kill someone else " was screened at several film festivals and among them at Pula Film Festival in the student category.

At the end of 2019, I participated in the group exhibition "Photodistorzija" in Poreč and won the first prize - a solo exhibition to be held in late 2021.

Another solo exhibition in Split is also being prepared, organized by the 'Mavena' association.

I am now in the process of completing my dissertation - an experimental film in which three female characters narrate on the experience of death and their stories are based on various folk songs of Istria.
